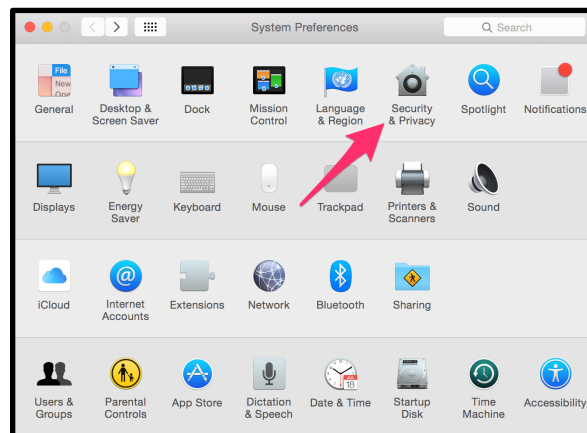
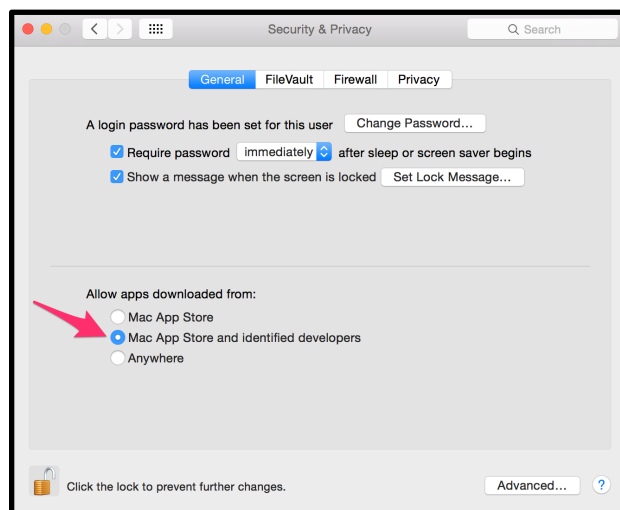


# Security Settings and Running a Downloaded Application in OSX

To run an application downloaded from the internet, you may need to adjust your security settings. To do so, open your System Preferences, then navigate to the “Security & Privacy” option.



In the “General” tab, check the option to allow apps downloaded from “Mac App Store and identified developers”.



Close your System Preferences, and you will now be able to launch the downloaded application.
