Issue Description: When changing the due date on an assignment whose previous due date was brought over during a course copy, both the old and new due date will appear for the assignment in the To Do module on the Home Page.

Steps to Replicate:

1. Log in as *Administrator*
2. Create a **Course**
3. Self-enroll as an *Instructor*
4. In any **Content Area** > Select **Assessments** > Click on **Assignment**
5. Include a Due Date on Assignments > **Submit**
6. Go to **Control Panel** > Select **Packages and Utilities**
7. Click **Course Copy**
8. Fill out fields as required

Note:

Copying into new or existing course does not affect outcome.

9. Click **Submit**
10. Click **Select All** button when selecting content.> Click Submit
11. Navigate to newly copied course
12. Edit Assignment
13. Change listed Due Date
14. Click **Submit**
15. Using Student Preview or a Test Enrollment, view copied course

Expected Behavior:

On the homepage in the To Do module, due dates displayed for student users are displayed a single time, matching the due date shown in the Assignment.

Observed Behavior:

On the homepage in the To Do module, students see two due dates for the single item, one for the previous due date and one for the updated due date.
